## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

SECTION 328.48(4), Florida Statutes, requires that the certificate of registration of each vessel operated, used, or stored on the waters of this state shall be available for inspection on the vessel for which issued whenever such vessel is in operation.

Electronic titles, also called e-titles, are motor vehicle, mobile home, or vessel titles held in electronic form by the department. Electronic titles prove ownership of a motor vehicle, mobile home, or vessel the same way a paper title does. Electronically maintaining the title eliminates the risk of losing the title and eliminates having to pay a fee to obtain a duplicate. An electronic title is also an effective fraud deterrent because potential thieves will not have access to your title. Sold your vehicle, mobile home or vessel? For your own protection, you are required by law to transfer the title and notify the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) within 30 days if you sell, donate or dispose of any motor vehicle or vessel. If you do not you could be legally responsible. Either go into a tax collector office or license plate agent with the new owner to transfer the title or go online to <https://www.flhsmv.gov/pdf/forms/82050.pdf> and download the Notice of Sale form. Fill it out, sign it and take it to the tax collector office or license plate agent for processing.

## **“DON'T BE A LITTER BOAT”**

**Pursuant to Section 328.48(5), Florida Statutes, this decal must be displayed by affixing it to the port (left) side of your vessel, either before or after the registration number. If a documented vessel, the decal may be affixed to a window or the windshield on the port side of the vessel. Only the current decal shall be displayed on the vessel.**

**TO APPLY:**

- 1. Hull surface must be free of dust, grease or wax.**
- 2. Peel decal from backing paper.**
- 3. Apply decal (face up) to hull surface.**
- 4. Do not apply decal to a surface that is extremely hot or cold.**

**If a dealer, the decal must be affixed with the registration number to a removable sign to be temporarily but firmly mounted upon or attached to vessel being tested or demonstrated.**

## **MOBILE HOME**

**Pursuant to Section 320.0815(2), Florida Statutes, this decal must be affixed to the lower left corner of the window closest to the street or road providing access to such residence.**

**TO APPLY:**

- 1. Window surface must be free of dust, grease and wax.**
- 2. Peel decal from backing paper.**
- 3. Apply decal (face up) to window surface.**
- 4. Do not apply decal to a surface that is extremely hot or cold.**
